



Cleanup Rules – Please Read Before Arriving

To keep everyone safe and make the cleanup run smoothly, please follow these guidelines:

How to Prepare Your Items

- All trash must be placed in **bags, boxes, cans, or bundles**
- Items must be light enough for **one person to safely handle**
- Loose or mixed materials must be **contained**

Large or heavy items such as concrete or railroad ties must be cut down to a size that one person can lift safely.

Items We Cannot Accept

- Tires
- Hazardous waste (chemicals, asbestos, liquids, Tar, etc.)
- Contaminated or special waste
- Compressed tanks (gas or otherwise)
- **Paint is allowed only if fully dried**
You may dry liquid paint by mixing it with cat litter or sand.

Questions About an Item?

If an item is questionable, **Stevens Disposal staff will decide at the site** whether it can be accepted. All decisions are final.

Recyclable Items Accepted

We gladly accept:

- Scrap metal
- Appliances (white goods)
- Stoves & refrigerators
- Furnaces & hot water tanks
- Farm equipment
- Other recyclable metal items as approved on site
